CITY HEALTH BUREAU HOSTS SPECIAL FLU CLINIC FOR CITY CHILDREN

The York City Bureau of Health, located at 435 W. Philadelphia Street, is hosting a walk-in flu clinic on Monday, December 8, 2014, from 8:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., as part of National Influenza Vaccination Week. Free flu vaccines will be available to all uninsured children and those on Medicaid who are 6 months to 18 years of age and who are City of York residents.

The Health Bureau reminds parents that all children 6 months of age and older should get their yearly flu vaccination now if that haven't already. The flu vaccine not only keeps immunized children healthy throughout flu season, but also makes the community healthier by protecting those who may not be able to get the immunization due to various medical reasons or age less than 6 months.
