WHEREAS, York City Council desires to establish regulations for mobile food vending within the City of York in an effort to promote the health, safety, comfort and convenience of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the intent of said regulations will be to establish reasonable rules, guidelines, fees and restrictions for mobile food vending and to encourage the sanitary, safe and convenient use of the city's public right-of-ways; and

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to establish an ad-hoc committee for the purpose of reviewing and making recommendations to Council for establishment of mobile food vending legislation as previously outlined;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, that the Mobile Food Vending Ad-Hoc Committee is hereby created and shall consist of the following:

1. A member of Downtown Inc.
2. The Director of Economic & Community Development or designee
3. Two (2) representatives from the mobile food truck industry
4. One representative each from three (3) York City brick and mortar food establishments
5. Two (2) York City Council members
6. One (1) representative from the mobile food cart industry

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that at least four (4) members of said committee shall be required for a quorum and that meetings shall be advertised in accordance with the law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said committee shall dissolve immediately upon adoption by City Council of mobile food vending legislation.
