WHEREAS, the City of York Police Civil Service Board, on Wednesday, April 24, 2013, certified an eligibility list of one hundred twenty (120) individuals for consideration to be appointed as a Probationary Police Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Chairperson of the Police Civil Service Board has certified the top three names on the eligibility list; and

WHEREAS, A vacancy exists in the York City Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the York City Police Department would like the ability to use the eligibility list to make a conditional offer of employment for the position of Probationary Police Officer to Douglas Klinefelter subject to Mr. Klinefelter’s ability to meet several conditions set forth below; and

WHEREAS, the following conditions must be met prior to an appointment to the position of Probationary Police Officer, to-wit:

1. Applicant must successfully pass a psychological examination as required by the City of York Police Civil Service Board.
2. Applicant must successfully pass a medical examination as required by the City of York Police Civil Service Board.

WHEREAS, If Douglas Klinefelter does not meet the above conditions, a conditional offer of employment would be offered to the next suitable individual in compliance with the Police Civil Service provisions, and subject to the same conditions for hiring as set forth above, and if no candidate is ultimately deemed qualified, the York City Police Department will request a new list of eligible individuals from the City of York Police Civil Service Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, that City Council hereby approves and accepts the City of York Police Civil Service Board’s eligibility list, certifying that one hundred twenty (120) individuals are eligible for consideration for appointment to the position(s) of budgeted vacant Probationary Police Officer after meeting the aforementioned conditions contained in this Resolution, and approves the appointment of a Probationary Police Officer effective on or about September 01, 2104, subject to the conditions set forth above.
