WHEREAS, the City of York is obligated to provide life insurance as a benefit of employment to the employees of the City.

WHEREAS, The Standard Insurance Company is the current provider for said employee life insurance coverage and has raised its proposed rate of coverage effective September 01, 2014 from \$0.129 per \$1,000.00 to \$0.16 per \$1,000.00 and no increase in the Accidental Death and Dismemberment premium of \$0.025 per \$ 1,000 that projects an overall annual premium of \$36,753.14; and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposal, through Evolution Consulting Services, to obtain proposals to provide employee life insurance coverage; and Reliance Standard Life Insurance Company proposed a premium rate of \$0.15 per \$1,000 and an Accidental Death and Dismemberment premium of \$0.01 per \$ 1,000 that projects to an overall premium of \$31,786.50;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, that the Mayor is authorized and the Controller is authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with Reliance Standard Life Insurance Company to provide life, death and dismemberment insurance to City employees for the period February 01, 2015 through December 31, 2016 at the hereinabove listed rates..
