**AN ORDINANCE**

Amending Article 1731 "Historic York," Subsection 1731.08 "Board Meetings," of the York City Codified Ordinances, to change meeting schedule from twice per month to once per month.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Article 1731.08 "Board Meetings" of the York city Codified Ordinances be amended as follows:

1731.08 BOARD MEETING.

The Board of Historical Architectural Review shall meet regularly and publicly at least ~~twice~~ once each month at regularly scheduled intervals, and may hold special meetings for cause at the call of the Chairman of the Board or upon request of any four members. Attendance at regularly scheduled meetings shall be mandatory and any member failing to attend six consecutive regularly scheduled meetings shall be deemed to no longer be a member of the Board. Any application for a building permit regulated by this article shall be considered by the Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting, ~~which is held at least five days after the date of the filing of the application~~ or at any special meeting of the Board called for such purpose. The person applying for the permit shall be advised of the time and place of such meeting and invited to appear to explain his reasons therefor.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the law.

**An Ordinance**

Amending Article 111.04 "Regular, Special and Transferred Meetings" of the Codified Ordinances to amend location of Council meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section One: That Article 111.04(a) and 111.04(b) be amended as follows:

**111.04 REGULAR, SPECIAL AND TRANSFERRED MEETINGS.**

(a) Regular meetings of Council shall be held at least once a month at the Council Chamber in the City Hall ~~building Annex, Market Way West Building,~~ or such location as approved by the affirmative vote of three members of Council, as such times are fixed by resolution of Council. The Mayor or the President of Council, as the case may be, may and, upon written request of a majority of the members of the Council, shall call a special or emergency meeting of the Council. The call shall designate the purpose of the special or emergency meeting and no other business shall be considered. All meetings of Council shall be open to the public and public notice of meetings shall be given as required by Title 65 PaCS, Section 709, Public Notice. The minutes of every meeting and the journal of proceedings shall be kept by the City Clerk and shall be signed by the officer presiding at such meeting and by the City Clerk.

(b) In case of any emergency arising, including but not limited to, the illness of any elected or appointed officer or employee of the City which prevents his presence in the Council Chamber in the City Hall Annex, ~~building~~ or designated location, Council may, by resolution or motion, authorize the transfer of any stated or special meeting to any other room in the City Hall building, ~~building annex of the City Hall,~~ or any other designated room or building, and there transact all business of the Council, including the passage of ordinances, resolutions or motions, with the same force and effect as though such meeting had been held and conducted in the Council Chambers. However, such transferred meeting shall be open to the public.

Section Two: This ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the law.
