AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING ARTICLE 338.02, IMPOSITION OF TAX, SUBSECTION (B) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF YORK, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO REFLECT AN INCREASE APPROVED IN THE 2012 BUDGET.

RECITALS:

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of York has enacted the ordinances of the City of York and has the power to amend said ordinances to reflect changes,

**WHEREAS**, The Budget approved by City Council for 2012, Bill No. 45, Ordinance 46, of 2012, contemplated a tax increase for Ordinance Article 338.02

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

338.02 IMPOSITION OF TAX.

(a) A tax for general revenue purposes is hereby imposed upon each parking transaction for a non-residential parking place at the percentage rate of the consideration for each such transaction set forth in subsection (b) of this section for the period from the effective date of this ordinance until December 31, 2006 and thereafter from year to year on a calendar year basis. No operator shall conduct such transactions without complying with all the provisions of this chapter and without collecting the tax herein imposed and paying it over to the City.

(b) The tax percentage rate of the consideration shall be as follows:

- (1) from the effective date of this ordinance to December 31, 2006 2%
- (2) January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007 4%
- (3) January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008 6%
- (4) January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009 8%
- (5) January 1, 2010 and thereafter 10% through December 31, 2011 10%
- (6) January 1, 2012 and thereafter 15%





**AN ORDINANCE**

AMENDING ARTICLE 338.03, ANNUAL LICENSE, SUBSECTION (A) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF YORK, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO REFLECT FEE CHANGES RECOMMENDED BY THE COMMONWEALTH FUNDED EARLY INTERVENTION PLAN PHASE II PREPARED IN OCTOBER 2011.

**RECITALS:**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of York has enacted the ordinances of the City of York and has the power to amend said ordinances to reflect changes,

**WHEREAS**, The Commonwealth funded Early Intervention Plan Phase II, prepared in October 2011, recommended a fee increases for Ordinance Article 338.03 from \$50.00 plus \$1.00 to \$100.00 plus \$2.00

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

**338.03 ANNUAL LICENSE.**

(a) No operator shall conduct business as a non-residential parking lot without first obtaining an annual license at a fee of ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00) plus one dollar (\$1.00)~~ **one hundred dollars (\$100.00) plus two dollars (\$2.00)** per space from the Tax Enforcement Administrator for the purpose of defraying the costs of administering this chapter. Such license shall be obtained by an operator for the each lot operated within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this ordinance and shall be renewed annually on or before January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Any person who intends to become an operator, or any operator who intends to increase the number of spaces available for non-residential parking, shall obtain a license or amended license before beginning such operation or expansion. At each parking lot the operator shall display the license in a conspicuous location at all times. Such license shall not be transferable between one operator and another or between one parking lot and another. Any operator who ceases to conduct the operation of a parking lot shall notify the Business Administrator and return the license applicable thereto.

(b) Nothing herein shall relieve the operator of the obligation to obtain a Business Privilege/Mercantile License.




