

**CITY OF YORK, PA – DEPARTMENT OF FIRE/RESCUE SERVICES
FIRE DEPARTMENT FEES (effective 4/1/12) (Revised 10/5/2016)**

Any occupancy that requires two (2) or more operational permits shall be charged the highest permit fee for the first permit plus \$20 per each additional required operational permit.
