AN ORDINANCE

Amending Article 513 "Vehicle Operation & Parking," Subsection 513.14 "Parking Prohibited in Specified Places" to reduce the penalty for prohibited standing or parking where official signs are erected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania that Article 513.14(k) be amended as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Article 513 "Vehicle Operation & Parking," Subsection 513.14 "Parking Prohibited in Specified Places" be hereby amended as follows:

- (k) At any place or within any area where official signs have been erected prohibiting standing or parking. (Ord. 4-1968 §1.)
 - (1) Penalties for violation. Whoever violates Section 513.14(k) shall be fined not less than fifty forty dollars (\$50.00) (\$40.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned for not more than ninety days
