



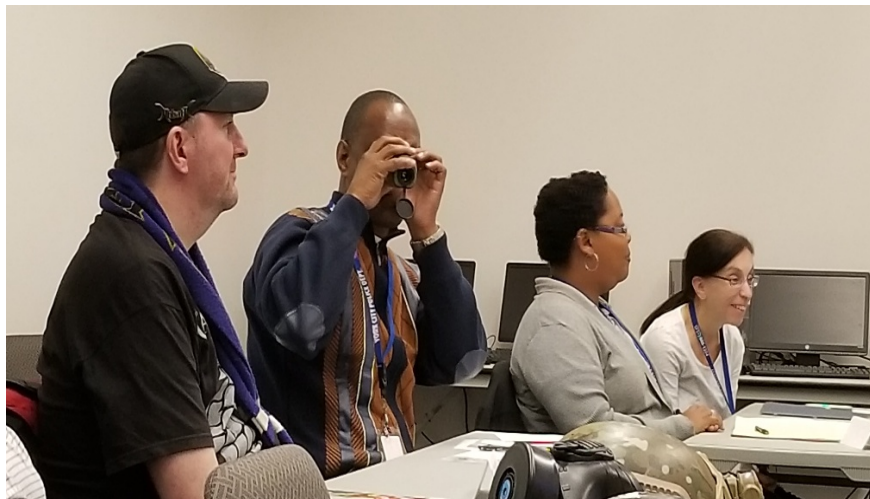
Press Release:
