**AN ORDINANCE**

Amending Article 737 "Minors Curfew" of the York City Codified Ordinances to define "guardian" with regard to overseeing a minor during curfew hours.

WHEREAS, The minors curfew ordinance is not intended to infringe upon the freedoms of resident youth, but rather to promote the safety and well-being of the City of York's youngest citizens, persons under the age of eighteen (18) years of age, whose inexperience renders them particularly vulnerable to becoming participants in unlawful activities, and to being victimized by older perpetrators of crime; and

WHEREAS, the term "guardian" is used throughout Article 737 but is not defined; and

WHEREAS, the intent of this amendment is to define the term "guardian";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, that Article 737 "Minors Curfew" subsection 737.01 "Definitions" is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION ONE: Article 737 "Minors Curfew" Subsection 737.01 "Definitions" is hereby amended as follows:

**737.01 DEFINITIONS.**

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meanings herein given:

- (a) "Minor" means any person under the age of eighteen years of age.
- (b) "Public place" means any public street, highway, road, alley, park, playground, sidewalk, vacant lot, or other area generally open to the public.
- (c) "Establishment" means any organization or place of business carried on for profit or for non-profit purposes, or any place of amusement or entertainment in which the public is invited.
- (d) "Operator" means any individual, firm, association, partnership, or corporation operating, managing, conducting or working for any establishment; and, whenever used in any clause prescribing a penalty, the term "operator," as applied to associations or partnerships shall include members or partners as well as employees or agents thereof, and as applied to corporations, shall include officers of the corporation thereof, and, in the case of any business or other entity operating under a fictitious name, shall include the owner, and his or her employees or other agents.
- (e) "Court" means any Magisterial District Justice Office or the York County Court of Common Pleas.
- (f) **"Guardian" means an individual eighteen years of age or older, authorized by law or by written statement by a parent or legal guardian, to oversee a minor. Written statements must include name of parent or legal guardian, name of minor, name of assigned guardian, and phone number of parent or legal guardian.**


