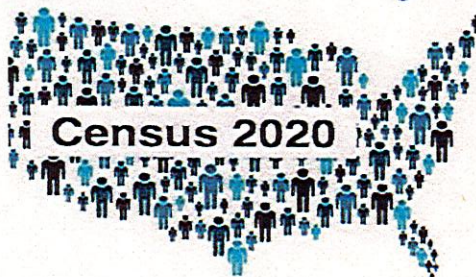


# Proclamation

## Cooperation with the 2020 U.S. Census Bureau to ensure and promote an accurate count for the County of York



*WHEREAS, an accurate count is vital to our community and residents' well-being by helping planners determine where to locate schools, day care centers, roads, public transportation, hospitals and other facilities, and achieving an accurate count of the nation's growing and changing population; and*

*WHEREAS, more than \$400 billion per year in federal and state funding is allocated to states and communities based, in part, on census data; and*

*WHEREAS, census data helps determine how many seats each state will have in the U.S. House of Representatives and often is used for redistricting of state legislatures and voting districts; and*

*WHEREAS, the 2020 Census creates jobs that stimulate economic growth and increases employment; and*

*WHEREAS, the information by the Census is confidential and protected by law under Title 13, U.S. Code.*

*NOW, THEREFORE, WE, THE COMMISSIONERS OF YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, do hereby proclaim that the County of York is committed to cooperate with the U.S. Census Bureau to help ensure a full and accurate count in 2020.*
