(5-8PM). While National Night Out may look a little different this year, we are continuing to work diligently to build strong community connections in a safe and healthy manner.

National Night Out is nationally sponsored by NATW, Ring, New York Life, Starbucks, AT&T, Academy Sports & Outdoors and co-sponsored locally by the York City Police Department.
