A RESOLUTION

Of the City of York, Pennsylvania, authorizing the filing of an application for Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) funds in the amount of \$1,500,000 for the Historic and Life Safety Renovations to York City Fire Stations project.

WHEREAS, the City of York desires to preserve and enhance The Laurel Fire Company building, constructed in 1877 and the Rex Hook and Ladder Company building, constructed in 1888; collectively known as York City Fire Station 99-1; and

WHEREAS, in August 2020, the City of York submitted a Single Application for Assistance to the Commonwealth Office of the Budget in the amount of \$3,500,000 for fire station renovations, and

WHEREAS, Governor Wolf authorized the release of \$1,500,000 in RACP funding in December of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of York has contracted with Bucharth-Horn Architects and engineers to design and develop plans for the historic renovation and mechanical upgrades to the Rex-Laurel Firehouse; and

WHEREAS, the City of York has been awarded said grant and it shall abide by and assume full responsibility for adherence to all the rules and regulations associated with these grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, that the Mayor is authorized, and the Controller is authorized to execute and submit an application and business plan for Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program funds in the amount of \$1,500,000 for the Historic and Life Safety Renovations to York City Fire Stations project.
