BONDING REQUIREMENTS

Contractor to supply one of the following financial assurances at the time of submission of bid. The financial assurance shall be submitted enclosed with the bid and shall be considered a necessary bid document. Failure to provide the financial assurance with the bid will render the bid null and void.

1. <u>BID BOND:</u> Secure and post a bid bond in the amount of 10% of the contract base bid. The bid bond shall be on a form acceptable to the City of York, and the company issuing the bond shall appear on the U.S. Treasury list of approved sureties. The bid bond shall be made out to both the client and the City of York as co-beneficiaries.

OR

2. <u>Certified check</u>: Submit a certified check in the amount of 10% of the contract base bid, made payable to both the client and the City of York.

Contractor awarded the bid shall submit one of the following performance assurances at time of contract execution. Contract will not be executed without performance surety. Failure to provide performance assurances and execute contract within twenty days of notification of contract award shall result in forfeiture of funds submitted as financial assurance.

1. <u>Performance Bond</u>: Contractor shall secure and post-performance and labor and material payment bonds, each in the amount of 100% of the contract price. The surety company issuing these bonds shall appear on the U.S. Treasury of approved sureties. Bonds are to be effective for term of construction, and one calendar year beyond date of final payment. Both the performance bond, and the labor and material bond shall be issued to the client and the City of York as co-beneficiaries.

OR

2. <u>Irrevocable letter of credit:</u> Contractor may submit an irrevocable letter of credit from a local lending institution made payable to both the client and the City of York in the amount of 100% of the contract price. The letter shall be valid for term of construction and one calendar year beyond date of final payment.

B. BID BOND

Bonding is required on this job. See bonding requirements.

C. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Since it is impossible to assess accurately the damage which may be caused by delay by the contractor in completing the work required by the contractor; and since actual damages may be great owing to obligations undertaken by the Agency with respect to the Project Area; the parties have agreed upon the sum of \$100.00 per day as liquidated damages for which the contractor and his sureties shall be liable to be paid by the contractor to the Local Public Agency for each calendar day beyond the date stipulated for completion.

DIVISION ONE: GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR DEMOLITION AND SITE CLEARANCE

A. REMOVAL OF DEBRIS, CLEANING, ETC.

- All rubbish and debris found on the site of Demolition Area at the start of the work as well as that resulting from the demolition activities or deposited on the site by others during the duration of the contract shall be removed and legally disposed of by the contractor, who shall keep the Project Area and public-rights-of-way reasonably clear at all times.
- 2) Upon completion of the work, the contractor shall remove all temporary construction, equipment, salvaged materials, trash and debris of all kinds, leaving the entire Project Area in a neat condition.
- 3) With the consent of the Redevelopment Authority, the Contractor may use suitable debris for specified fill. Perishable or organic materials must not become a part of any fill placed or left on the site.

B. **DUMPING AND FEES**

- The Demolition Contractor will comply with the Pennsylvania Solid Waste Management Act No. 241, Section 7.a., Chapter 75 of the Department of Environmental Protection Regulations. All demolition rubble shall be hauled to the approved landfill specified in your bidding documents. Temporary storage of rubble on the contractor's private site, or elsewhere, is not permitted.
- 2) Final payment for the work may be withheld until disposal of all debris is fully documented. Contractor must provide receipts or weighbills showing proper disposal of all materials.

C. **FINAL GRADING AND SEEDING**

Contractor shall demolish and remove all walls and foundations a minimum of 3'-0 below finish grade. Upon demolition and removal of remainder of building, and after attention to basement floors and adjoining structure walls per specifications, Contractor shall backfill and grade with a finish course of 6" thickness of earth fill, not including sand or clay. Refer to site specifications.

D. **SEEDING**

1) Contractor shall backfill and grade with a 8" thick finish course of clean topsoil consisting of friable soil of loamy character, containing an amount of organic matter normal to the region, capable of sustaining healthy plant life, free from sub-soils, roots, and other deleterious matter. Final fill shall not include sand, rock, or clay. Refer to subject site specifications.

- The final grade shall be completed and raked even to permit the mowing with a Reel Type Mower. Surface is to be graded to allow for water runoff to existing public right-of-ways.
- 3) The entire disturbed area will be tilled and sown with a mixture of 50/50 annual rye and tall fescue grass seed at a rate of twenty (2) pounds per square yard, and promptly mulched with straw at the rate of one (1) pound per square yard.
- 4) The demolition contractor is responsible for watering and early maintenance necessary to assure germination and growth of the lawn areas.

E. WAGE RATE REQUIREMENTS

Davis-Bacon does **not** apply unless we specifically state otherwise for a particular case.

This project **DOES** require Pennsylvania prevailing wage rates under Serial Number 22-06563. Certified payroll reports MUST be provided. Wage rates are attached to this document.

F. TIME

- 1) Contractor shall begin work as soon as reasonably possible after being notified by the Redevelopment Authority of the City of York to proceed with the work.
- All work shall be fully completed within thirty (30) calendar days from the date the successful Contractor has been notified by the city to proceed with the work, for each of the properties awarded. Any workdays lost by the contractor because of inclement weather, or for any other reason beyond his control may be additional to this completion deadline.
- 3) A request for an extension of time must be submitted in writing to the RDA and approved by owner BEFORE any then current completion date stated on the proceed order or subsequent change orders and extension requested.

G. **RELATED CONDITIONS**

- Documents affecting the contractor for this work include, but are not necessarily limited to, The City of York, Bureau of Housing Services, General Conditions of Contract, supplementary Contract Conditions, Performance Specifications and Sections in Division 2 of the subject site specifications.
- The Contractor is responsible to assure that all work performed follows current building codes, local ordinances, and all government regulations applicable to the work.

H. QUALITY ASSURANCE

- Use adequate numbers of skilled workmen who are thoroughly trained and experienced in the necessary crafts and who are completely familiar with the specified requirements and the methods needed for proper performance of the work of these Specifications.
- 2) Provide all of the necessary tools and equipment of sufficient capacity to expedite timely and satisfactory completion of the work.
- 3) Craftsmen and operators may be requested to document experience or certification in the work being performed.
- 4) Work may be stopped if any portion of the work is found to be in disagreement with specifications, non-compliant with building codes, or in violation of state regulations and/or local ordinances. The contractor will be responsible for all costs associates with such work stoppage.

I. BUILDING DEMOLITION

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1. Work included:

A) Demolish and remove from the site all structural components of the subject property except for those items so indicated on the specifications to remain.

1.2 Surface conditions:

A. Examine the areas and conditions under which work of these specifications will be performed. Correct conditions detrimental to timely and proper completion of the Work. Do not proceed until unsatisfactory conditions are corrected.

1.2 Demolition:

A. General:

- 1. Prior to start of demolition, carefully study these specifications as well as the current York City Building Codes; notify the RDA representative of any discrepancies between these specifications and the Codes.
- 2. The Contractor is responsible for obtaining and maintaining all necessary permits for the work as well as regulation instructions from the proper regulating agencies.
- 3. In company with the RDA representative on request, visit the site and verify the extent of demolition to be performed under this Contract.
- 4. During site visit with RDA representative, outline procedures to safely

disconnect demolition structure from any adjoining structures and protect any nearby structures from potential damage during demolition.

- 5. Structural support as well as weather proofing of adjoining structures or securing opened areas is fully the responsibility of the contractor.
- 6. Review specifications concerning party wall treatment for adjoining structures.
- 7. Shut off, cap, and otherwise protect existing public utility lines in accordance with the requirements of the public agency or utility having jurisdiction, as well as in compliance with city codes.
 - a) Contractor shall provide written verification of proper termination of all utilities to RDA.
- 8. Use means necessary to prevent dust and debris becoming a nuisance to the public, to neighbors, and to other work being performed on or near the site.
- 9. Provide fencing, barricades, warning devices and/or flaggers to adequately protect the work site and prevent unauthorized entry to the work areas. Maintain same at all times until final completion and acceptance by owners.
- 10. All demolished materials and salvage shall be considered the property of the contractor upon commencement of the work and shall be completed removed from the site along with tools and equipment upon completion of the work.

1.4 Notifications:

A. Notify regulating agencies as required. i.e.: D.E.P.

- B. Notify the RDA Representatives two business days prior to:
 - 1. Disconnection of utilities.
 - 2. Separation of adjoining structures.
 - 3. Starting demolition.
 - 4. Final debris removal
 - 5. Backfilling of basements
 - 6. Final grading and seeding.
- C. Notify the RDA Representative, immediately upon discovery of any

differing site condition or occurrence that may impede the progress of the work or cause additional cost to the owner.

1.5. Procedures:

- A. The subject properties will be carefully disconnected from adjoining structures by hand before large equipment is utilized for demolition.
- B. Adjoining structures will be fully protected as demolition progresses. The contractor is responsible to provide all shoring and structural support necessary to protect and preserve adjacent property.
- C. Completely remove all above and below ground construction and utility installations of any kind to a minimum depth of three (3) feet below the ground surface.
- D. ALL footings and foundations will be removed completely. The basement floors will be broken up to permit proper drainage.
- E. All rocks, concrete, or masonry larger than 8" x 8" x 8" as well as any roots, rubbish, or debris shall be removed from the basement or cavity before backfill may begin.
- F. The contractor will notify the RDA 48 hours in advance to inspect the site as work progresses and obtain approvals before any work is covered.
- G. Contractor must take interior and exterior photographs of the property prior to demolition as well as exterior photographs of the adjoining properties prior to demolition.

DIVISION TWO; SITE WORK GENERAL

- G2.A.l General: The General Conditions and Division One General Requirements shall apply to this section of the specifications.
- G2.A.2 The contractor shall notify all adjoining property owners in writing ten (10) days before work commences. Verification of notification shall be given to the RDA, prior to starting demolition.
- G2.A.3 The contractor is responsible to correct any damages to adjoining and adjacent buildings or properties caused by the demolition of these structures. Contractors are required to document existing conditions of adjoining properties prior to commencement of any work.
- G2.A.4 Any reference to homeowner in these contracts refers to the RDA or nearby property owner AND tenants.

G2.B. <u>DEMOLITION</u>

- G.2.B.1 The contractor is responsible for obtaining all permits and regulation instructions from proper authorities, as well as complying with all codes and ordinances.
- G.2.B.2 Contractor shall remove and seal all utility hook-ups and make sure utilities have ceased supplying these hook-ups. Contractor shall provide written verification that all utilities have been properly terminated and safely sealed as per utility regulations to the RDA prior to starting demolition.
- G.2.B.3 The contractor shall remove the structures and all component parts thereof, including footings and foundation walls, to a minimum depth of three (3) feet below ground surface. Remove and dispose of all masonry, lumber, pipe and all other materials such as debris, rubbish, brush and trees.
- G.2.B.4 Contractor shall break up entire basement or cellar floors sufficiently to permit proper drainage. No solid slabs larger than 8 inch by 8 inch shall remain.
- G.2.B.5 Use means necessary to prevent dust from becoming a nuisance to the public, to neighbors, and to other work being performed on or near the site.

 Transmitting dirt, stone, or debris onto the public ways is strictly prohibited.
- G.2.B.6 Barricade open holes and depressions occurring as part of this work. Protect structures, utilities, sidewalks, pavements and other facilities from damage caused by settlement, lateral movement, washout, and other hazards created by operation under this section.

G.2.B.7 Disposal Site

Prior to execution of the contract, the lowest responsible bidder shall be required to submit to the RDA proof that the disposal site or facility to be used by the Bidder has been licensed and approved by the Department of Environmental Protection Division of Solid Waste Management. Site designation is required on the bid form submitted.

G.2.B.8 During job progress and upon completion, the Contractor shall provide the RDA with certified receipts evidencing all materials removed and disposed. Payment maybe withheld until the RDA receives all documentation.

G.2.C. BACK FILL;

- G.2.C.1 The contractor shall supply all clean material for back-fill. The materials used to be no larger than 8" x 8" x 8" except for the final 3 feet of fill which is to be ground fill with ingredients no larger than 4" x 4" x 4".
- G.2.C.2 Back fill of approved material shall not be used in lifts of more than twelve (12) inches and all lifts are to be compacted to a minimum of 90% compaction.
- G.2.C.3 The contractor shall back fill to 8" below surrounding surface levels to grade. Remaining 8" shall be clean topsoil spread uniformly over the area. Topsoil shall consist of friable soil of loamy character, containing an amount of organic matter normal to the region, capable of sustaining healthy plant life, free from sub-soils, roots, and other deleterious matter. Surface is to be graded to allow for water runoff to existing public right-of-ways.

G.2.D. <u>FINAL GRADE AND SEED:</u>

- G.2.D.1 Finish grade to keep water from running on neighbors and seed according to specifications.
 - Make sure adjoining properties are kept free of erosion and runoff at all times and that no damage occurs to adjoining properties. Promptly repair any damage.
- G.2.D.2 After demolition and backfill procedures are complete, contractor shall till entire ground surface, rake and resow using mixture of 50/50 annual rye and tall fescue grass seed. Cover entire area with straw to keep moisture in and prevent erosion.

DIVISION TWO: SITE WORK SPECIFIC

- S2.A. General: The General Conditions, Division One General Requirements, and applicable sections of the Performance Specifications shall apply to this section of the specifications.
- S2.A.1 The contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to perform the following specified work in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and City Codes.
- S2.A.2 The contractor shall also provide to RDA proofs of disposal of asbestos material and LBP hazardous waste, if any, as well as show compliance with E.P.A. and D.E.P. regulations where applicable, and/or in accordance with City Codes.

S2.B. DEMOLITION;

All and entire structures:

- A. The contractor will tear down and remove all footings and foundations, slabs, and old steps of property. Leave existing curbs and sidewalks in front of properties. Should any damage be done to existing curbs and sidewalks, sections are to be replaced per City Codes, at the demolition contractor's expense.
- B. If asbestos is present on job, it shall be removed in accordance to E.P.A. and D.E.P. regulations, and paperwork submitted to the RDA.
- C. Backfill and grade to keep water from running on neighboring lots, also seed as per General Specifications.
- D. Make sure adjoining properties are kept dry at all times and no damage occurs to adjoining properties, or public ways. Promptly repair any damage.
- E. Level lot and grade to slope as needed.
