# **Case #1 – 323 E. Poplar St.**

Arc Property Services, LLC has submitted an application to replace and paint windows on the front of apartment building.

## Discussion:

Fire damaged property. Windows destroyed to be replaced. Original to be replaced in-kind.

## Case #2 - 620 S. George St.

Michael Miller submitted an application to remove front mansard slate and install new GAF Slateline shingles with .032 aluminum flashings. Remove upper flat roof system and install 60 mil EPDM rubber roof system with .032 aluminum edge metal.

#### Discussion:

The sloped roof is not visible from the street. Slate mansard to be replaced by asphalt. Timberline HD product.

#### Action:

Mr. Buffington made a motion to approve amending material type to Timberline and Ms. Pottorff seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

## Case #3 - 364 E. Market St.

Tim Riley submitted an application to replace the roof.

#### Discussion:

Replacement not visible from the public right of way.

#### Action:

Mr. Kunkle made a motion to recommend approval as presented and Mr. Buffington seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

## Case #4 - 22 N. Broad St.

Bryan Brown submitted an application to replace the fence and breezeway gate.

Proposed pressure treated 6' fence with dog-eared top. Alley door to match. Very inappropriate addition work windows including T111 siding over brick and elimination of windows. Windows are vinyl.
