Bill No. 52, Session 2023, A Bill amending the FY2023 budget in the amount of \$3,500,000.00 for Affordable Housing & Homeowner Relief programs, which was introduced by Walker at the November 8 meeting of Council and read by short title, came up for final passage. Marilyn Hake, resident, asked how residents can apply for relief programs and what will be the criteria to qualify.

President Walker said that will be determined by the mayor. She said our consulting firm, Anser Advisory, will be hashing out the details before we offer the program to residents. She said funding is in the 2023 budget and will roll over to 2024.
