2026 Annual Action Plan

The 2026 Annual Action Plan specifies available resources to meet the identified needs. The financial resources the City expects to have available include an entitlement grant of \$1,347,184 from the Community Development Block Grant funds and \$465,853.04 in HOME entitlement funds. The program period will be January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025. The York Housing Authority will have other funds available including Section 8 assistance and HUD funds for public housing modernization.
