



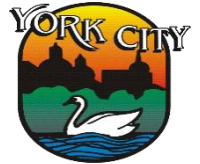

**SUMMER PARK PROGRAM**  
**RULES & REGULATIONS**  
**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

The following Rules and Regulations will be monitored and enforced by Summer Park Staff during the Summer Park Program. All children participating in the Summer Park Program will be expected to know, understand and abide by these rules.

The Rules and Regulations are as follows:



- 1) No swearing, name calling or teasing of fellow campers of Summer Park Program Staff.
- 2) Fighting, pushing or shoving and/or kicking will not be tolerated.
- 3) No smoking or consuming of any alcohol or drugs will be tolerated.
- 4) No stealing.
- 5) No littering.
- 6) Respect must be shown to Summer Park Staff and fellow campers at all times.
- 7) Vandalism or damage to park equipment, park box or program supplies will not be tolerated.
- 8) Discrimination of one's racial, religious and/or one cultural background will not be tolerated.
- 9) The Summer Park Program Staff is ultimately responsible for the well-being of each camper. Campers are expected to listen to and follow the directions of Park Staff.
- 10) A parent/legal guardian must sign each camper into and out of camp each day.

**A three (3) strike policy will be enforced when rules and regulations are broken (please refer to the Behavior Policy section, Overview & General Information), and any or all of the following disciplinary procedures may occur depending on the severity of the problem including:**

- 1) Verbal Warning
- 2) Time Out – time spent sitting at the picnic table away from other campers.
- 3) Time Off – temporary suspension from the Summer Park Program.
  - a. Parent/guardian will receive written notification.
  - b. Parent/guardian must schedule a meeting with Summer Park Program staff prior to the child returning to participate in the Summer Park Program. To schedule this appointment, please call the main office at 717-854-1587 or speak directly with Summer Park Staff to schedule the return appointment.
- 4) Expulsion from the Summer Park Program.
  - a. Parent/guardian must direct all questions to the Summer Park Program Director or the Interim Director of Public Works. Please contact the main office at 717-854-1587.
  - b. Child is no longer permitted to participate in the Summer Park Program for the season.
