AN ORDINANCE

Amending the fiscal year 2026 City Budget for the Economic & Community Development department, Police and Recreation and Parks for Fund 29 to correct the budgets for the programs resulting in a budget transfer of \$4,584,865.45 and adding additional funds for Supporting program in the amount of \$4,584,865.45.

WHEREAS, the City of York received funds under the American Rescue Plan Act "ARPA" that it obligated to eligible uses under the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund; and

WHEREAS allocations to certain grantees have been amended or recaptured, thus requiring the amendment of the City of York 2026 budget to show the incoming revenue into account 29; and

WHEREAS, it's been determined that the expenses included in the FY2026 budget for the reallocated programs need corrected to accurately represent the remaining project funding available resulting in a budget reduction of \$4,584,865.45; and

WHEREAS, it's also been requested that funding be shifted from the Supported program in the amount of \$4,584,865.45; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Bureau has reviewed the 2026 Budget and has determined the budget must be amended to make the requested adjustments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, that the City of York 2026 Budget is hereby amended in accordance with the following schedule:

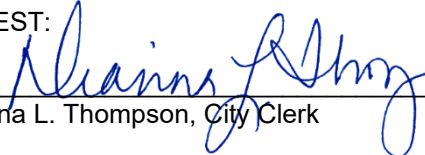

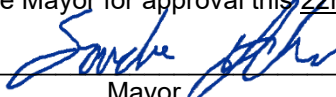
